


Triple Goddess Pilgrimage May 15-26, 2018



Tuesday, May 15th/2018-leave the states

Wednesday, May 16-arrive CDG, Paris, France: Group needs to arrive to the hotel no later than 2 p.m.

- Check into **Hôtel Henri IV**, group meeting, astrological chart discussion, & overall intent for this journey.
- Notre Dame Cathedral to set our intention as a group to the 3 aspects of the Goddess, symbolized in your astrological chart by the Moon, Venus and Black Moon Lilith. Mary-Isis, the Magdalene and the Black Madonna will be your muses on this sacred journey.
- **Evening welcome dinner (included)**

Thursday, May 17th-

- Breakfast, then group work throughout Paris early in the morning to mid-day
- L'église de la Madeleine, a church dedicated to Mary Magdalene and a building later to honor Napoleon & the Obelisk, one of the original pillars from the Temple of Luxor in Egypt, where its twin still stands. This connects to Aset (Isis), one the primary goddesses from which all others have come through history and religion. Here we will do some meditative work, and walk through the Tuileries Gardens.
- Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Here we set our petitions to be fulfilled at Lourdes. A young novice, Catherine, had two visitations here by the Holy Mother. Many miracles have taken place here, and the church holds Catherine's incorrupt body.
- Free afternoon to do as you wish-boat down the Seine, visit the Eiffel Tower, take in the Louvres, shop the Champs Elysees, or visit the famous Père Lachaise cemetery
- Meet for group dinner close to the hotel.

- In this famous basilica we will walk the labyrinth, and have a private lecture in the crypt of the Black Madonna at 1:15 p.m. with private time to meditate.
- Stay overnight at Chartres, see the special effects of the city lit up at night. **Best Western Hotel Spa Grand Monarque**
- Group can make spa arrangements on their own should you desire.
- Meet for dinner at the hotel-table reserved
- Optional-walk at night in the city to see Chartres “City of Light “ display

- Breakfast at the hotel and then our coach takes us to Orly airport to Toulouse
- Domestic flight Orly to Toulouse
- Van pick up at Toulouse airport and drive to Lourdes-check into **Hôtel Sainte-Rose**
- Visit the Sanctuary of our Lady of Lourdes and the Cathedral. The Sanctuary is a destination for pilgrimage and sick pilgrims are reputed to be miraculously healed by Lourdes water. Lourdes rose to prominence in France and abroad due to the apparitions of Mary the Holy Mother seen by the peasant girl Bernadette Soubirous, who was later canonized.

- Montsegur Castle—Château de Montségur is probably the best known of all Cathar Castles. It's famous as the last Cathar stronghold, which fell after a 10 month siege in 1244.
- Niaux Caves—Like Lascaux, this site contains many prehistoric paintings of superior quality, in the case of Niaux from the Magdalenian period. We will do some deep inner work here, as well as visit the cave paintings.

Thursday, May 24th

- Market in Esperaza for a fun day. The colourful traditional markets in the charming village of Esperaza has many handicrafts, clothes, organic produce, artisan breads, olives and cheese. Esperaza was one of the pilgrimage routes to the Santiago de Compostela.
- After lunch (not included) go to Alet Les Bains which is situated within a natural 'Venus Temple,' a five pointed star location energetically imprinted into the landscape between several mountains and villages. This has a long history of seekers of wisdom through the Mystery Schools, Druids, Knights Templar and Magdalenes. It is also the place where Nostradamus lived and did his prognostications.
- We will visit the Fontaine des Amours, and go further downstream to work at the Benitier, where two rivers meet, and where it is rumored Mary Magdalene baptized converts. The word Benitier means 'baptismal font.'

- Visit Notre Dame de Marceille. This special church is filled with symbology from the Knights Templar, though the site itself was revered long before their presence. History tells us of a chapel being present here since the 1000s. A Black Madonna is still found in the church, her presence is palpable.

- At the small nearby water shrine, dedicated to Mary, we experience a water blessing ceremony for vision, healing, and gratitude to take back home with us.
